

Harwich Festival 2022

20x20 Exhibition June 22nd to July 3rd
Guidance for Artists



Brief: Make an artwork measuring exactly 20cmx20cm.

- **Guidelines** - Work must measure exactly 20cmx20cm, including frame if applicable
- **Any medium** – painting, drawing, printing, photography, collage, ceramic, glass, fabric, knitting, crochet etc.
- **Open submission** – anyone can enter; professional and amateur artists, makers and creatives of all ages.
- **No selection** – all works that are entered will be accepted and shown as long as they measure 20cm by 20cm, have a hanging device and contact details on the back.
- **Venue** - to be shown at the Old Chapel, 30 Kings Head St, Harwich.
- **Hand in work at** -Harwich Arts and Heritage Centre, Dovercourt (the old Adult Education Centre next to Mayflower Primary School).
- **Submission dates** – **Monday 6th June to Saturday 11th June.** The work will be hung from Thu 16th June to Tue 21st June excluding Sat & Sun
- Enter as many works as you like - £1.00 per work. Free submission for persons under 18 years.
- The work should be made on (or fixed to) a **rigid support**, with a hanging device attached to the back. If the work is on a conventional canvas or on a wooden panel or framed, then mirror plates can be screwed onto the back, one plate on each side at the centre point.
- **Name** and **contact details** and if you want to sell your work, **the price** to be attached to the back.
- A commission of 10% on each sale will go to the Festival fund. No commission on work by persons under 18 years.
- **Collection of works** – from the venue at the takedown of the exhibition on Mon 4th July and Tue 5th July or later at the Harwich Arts and Heritage Centre.
- The Festival Visual Arts Panel reserves the right to reject any work that that might cause offence.
- Work is submitted at the owners risk, the Festival takes no responsibility for loss or damage.
