20x20 Exhibition: June 22nd to July 1st at the Old Chapel 30 King's Head Street Harwich

Guidance for Artists

Brief: Make an artwork measuring exactly 20cmx20cm, including frame if applicable.

Any medium- painting, drawing, printing, photography, collage, ceramics, glass, textile art etc.

Open submission- anyone can enter; professional and amateur artists, makers and creatives of all ages.

No selection- all works that are entered will be accepted and shown as long as they measure 20cmx20cm, have a hanging device and contact details on the back. Harwich Festival reserves the right to reject any work that might cause offence.

Hand in work at the Harwich Arts and Heritage Centre next to the Mayflower Primary School.

Submission dates- Monday 5th June to Friday 9th between 10.00 and 16.00 and Saturday 10th June between 10.00 and 13.00.

Enter as many works as you like at £1 per work. Free submission for persons under 18 years.

The work should be made on (or fixed to) a **rigid support**, with a hanging device attached to the back. Mirror plates are easiest for us to hang the work, one plate on each side at the centre point.

Name and contact details and if you want to sell your work, the **price** to be attached to the back.

A commission of 10% on each sale will go to the Festival fund. No commission on work by persons under 18 years.

Collection of works- from the venue on takedown day Monday 3rd July afterwards from the Harwich Arts and Heritage Centre, weekdays between 10.00 to 16.00. Please collect works by the end of July.

Work is submitted at the owners risk, the Harwich Festival takes no responsibility for loss or damage.

Feeling more adventurous, in addition to the 20x20 pictures we'll be accepting 20 pictures up to a maximum size of 50cm on a first come first served basis.

We are looking for volunteers to help us invigilate the exhibition.
